- Individual





# TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF THE COMPETITION

## 1

### Qualification Rounds

2 rounds of 36 arrows (72 arrows). 180 seconds per end of 6 arrows.

- 1.1 Barebow Women
- 1.2 Barebow Men
- 1.3 Barebow Women Master (Age of 50 or over as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2026)
- 1.4 Barebow Men Master (Age of 50 or over as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2026)
- 1.5 3 ends official practice prior to qualification round on the Field of Play (FOP). Immediate follow scoring once the field is reset.
- 1.6 Shooting qualification rounds will be organized in ABCD format.

## 2

### Elimination Rounds

#### 2.1 Individual Elimination

1/32 (one thirty-second) for Barebow Open category, 1/16 (one-sixteenth) for Barebow Master, men and women respectively.

Set system - 3 arrows per set - 6 set points. 90 seconds per end of 3 arrows.

1/32, 1/16, 1/8 - 2 archers per target; 1/4, 1/2 = 1 archer per target.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches - Alternate Shooting (20 seconds per arrow).

#### 2.2 Team Elimination

1/16 (one-sixteenth) for men and women team respectively.

Set system - 6 arrows per set - 5 set point. 120 seconds per end of 6 arrows. 1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2 & Bronze Medal Matches - shoot at the same time.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches - Alternate Shooting.





# TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF THE COMPETITION

## 2.3 Mixed Team Elimination

1/16 (one-sixteenth).

Set system – 4 arrows per set – 5 set points.

80 seconds per end of 4 arrows.

1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2 & Bronze Medal Matches – shoot at the same time.

Gold Medal (Final) Matches – Alternate Shooting.

## 2.4 Gold Medal (Final) Matches

Alternate Shooting. Team / Club must appoint an agent for athlete(s) when going into Gold Medal Matches.

2.4.1 For medal matches, practice field and warm-up field are available for athletes.

2.4.2 6 targets provided with the same direction as the FOP.

2.4.3 Each competing athlete or team is allocated with 20 minutes practice session prior to their match.

2.4.4 Athletes are not permitted to use scope on the medal match FOP.

## 3 Equipment Inspection

3.1 To be conducted on 29th April 2026 during practice session from 09:00h till 15:00h. Random inspection will also be conducted during competition days.

3.2 Spare equipment must also be brought for inspections.

3.3 Team captain or team officials are responsible to check the details of their athletes such as name, team ID numbers are correct.

3.4 Inform the Judges if details are not correct so Judges will inform Results Team for correction.

3.5 Athletes' numbers will be distributed during competition day.

3.6 Athletes' number are compulsory to be worn on the quiver, facing the waiting line while shooting.





# PARTICIPANTS

1. Open for individuals, archery clubs, associations, and community (mentioned as Team after this) from Malaysia and Asia.
2. Each Team consists of maximum 4 men and 4 women.
3. Team Name must be clear and different to the other team names although from same club or country.
4. Number of officials based on inquiry.
5. All athletes and officials participating in this tournament will be issued with only one accreditation card (ID Card). One official allowed for maximum of 3 archers from the same team.
6. Accreditation card (ID Card) must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas. No entry without ID Card.

# RULES

1. The current World Archery Rules will be the guidelines to this championship.
2. Athletes and officials are assumed to understand the rules of the competition.

# DRESS REGULATIONS

1. Athletes, officials, and staff should wear full Team uniform. Uniform shirt and shorts/pants/skirts must be of the same color for the members of the same team/club for Team Rounds and Medal Matches. Denim material is prohibited.
2. Clothing and equipment shall not be camouflage.
3. Sport shoes or walking boots shall be worn by all athletes and officials, these may be different styles but shall cover the entire foot.
4. Hand sleeves must be in the same color in one team. Hand sleeves for Gold Medal (Final) Match must be in the same color of uniform dominant color OR white.
5. All athletes' names and country names are mandatory on the back of their team's uniform shirt or hijab for Muslimah athletes wearing long hijab.





# TEAM AND MIXED TEAM FORMAT

1. Top 3 archers of each team/club in the qualification round will be ranked together as one team for team match.
2. The results of the 3 highest scoring members of the team will automatically be used for the team match. If Official / Team's Captain wishes to make changes, please use the form to name the archers that will be competing in the team match.
3. The form to be given to Result Team or COJ, 30 (thirty) minutes prior to team match start.
4. Number of mixed-team registered per team/club can be more than one mixed- team. In the case more than one mixed-team registered from one team/club, name of the archers must be mentioned on the mixed-team registration form respectively.
5. Name of mixed-team should be added with code such as 1,2,3, etc. or A,B,C etc.
6. This is an exception i.e. Local Rule from the organizing committee, not WA Rules.

## AWARD, MEDALS AND PRIZES

1. Participation Certificate for all participants, both athlete and official.
2. Winners Certificate for individual qualification and all elimination champions.
  - 2.1 Individual Qualification Rounds : Rank 1 – 3
  - 2.2 Individual Elimination Rounds : Rank 1 – 4
  - 2.3 Team Elimination Rounds : Rank 1 – 4
  - 2.4 Mixed Team Elimination Rounds : Rank 1 – 4
3. Medals for team winners will be for 3 person.

# OTHER MATTERS OF IMPORTANCE

1. Athletes and Team Officials are strongly expected to attend and take part in the opening ceremony and other ceremonies actively.
2. Please keep the cleanliness and tidiness of the competition venue.
3. All results and updated documents will be uploaded on IANSEO and, or participant's WhatsApp group.
4. Athletes and Team Officials has to respect rules on the field and out of field during all event.
5. Failure to respect the rules could be penalised with the participation cancellation of the team involved.
6. Transportation : Venue, Airport, etc. Own arrangement.
7. Meals during practice, eliminations, finals, and other occasions. Own arrangement.
8. All medalist to be ready at athletes' holding area 15 minutes prior to medal ceremonies.
9. Medical team and ambulance services are available on site for any emergency.
